Installation

Make sure the SoftwareSilo Composer repository is configured and create a current backup or deployment rollback point.

Replace `repo.softwaresilo.io`, `softwaresilo`, `https://repo.softwaresilo.io/` and `<token>` with the repository details shown under **Account > Licenses** in your SoftwareSilo account — see [Installation & Updates](#).

```
composer config bearer.repo.softwaresilo.io <token>
composer config repositories.softwaresilo composer
https://repo.softwaresilo.io/
composer require mageb2b/payment-profile:*
php bin/magento module:enable MageB2B_ExtensionManager
MageB2B_PaymentProfile
php bin/magento setup:upgrade
```

Production-mode stores normally require dependency injection compilation and static-content deployment. Follow your normal release process, then clear the Magento cache.

Verify the installation

```
php bin/magento module:status MageB2B_PaymentProfile
```

The module should be enabled. Administrators with the required permissions should see:

- [Stores > Configuration > MageB2B > Payment Profile](#)
- [Customers > Payment Profiles](#)

Important: defaults on a fresh installation

The extension ships with **Enable = Yes** and **Hide all payment methods when no allowed method is resolved = Yes**. Until the first profile exists, every checkout produces no match — so a fresh installation hides **all payment methods** for every buyer.

Immediately after installing, set the no-match setting to **No** in [Configuration](#), or create and test profiles before the store goes live.
