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Login Context System

Understand how sub-account login sessions work.

Overview

The login context determines permissions and data access for each session.

Context Types

Context	Description
Main Account	Full access, admin rights
Sub-Account	Limited by role permissions
Impersonation	Admin acting as customer

Session Data

Each login stores:

- Account type (main/sub)
- Parent account ID
- Permission set
- Session token

Context Switching

Main account holders can:

1. View as sub-account
2. Test permissions
3. Switch back instantly

API Behavior

REST/SOAP (via API add-on) respects context:

- Returns appropriate data
- Enforces permissions
- Logs actions correctly

Security

- Sessions are isolated
- Permissions enforced server-side
- Audit logging enabled
